It provides a forum for legal scholars and jurists to report research findings for policy making through innovative and advanced research. Well researched and original papers on topical legal issues are hereby welcome for the second edition of the Journal.

Guidelines to Contributors 1. Language

The language of the manuscript must be English (British standards) and expressed in active note, simple and plain words. Spelling and grammar must be consistent with British English. Thus, all entries must reflect a formal academic papers, with a consistent writing style that is logical, precise and professional.

2. Originality

Articles must be original and must not have been submitted for consideration and publication elsewhere. All factual statements must be supported by sources or research evidence that is properly cited.

3. Length of Paper

The length of the paper should not be more than 20 pages including tables, figures, references and appendices (if any). Articles should be typed in 1.5 line spacing. However, footnotes should appear in single line spacing in an A4 paper. Authors are encouraged to write as concisely as possible, but not at the expense of clarity. The character should be Times New Roman with 12 font size except for the footnotes which appear in 10 font size.

4. Title Page

The title page should include: (i) a concise and informative title (ii) the name(s) of the author(s) (iii) the institutional affiliation(s) and address (es) of the author(s), (iv) the telephone number and the e-mail address of the corresponding author.

5. Abstract

Provide an abstract of between 150 and 200 words which must include the objectives of the study, methodology, findings/results, method of data collection and summary of recommendations. The abstract should not contain any undefined abbreviations or unspecified references. It should be in single-line spacing and in one paragraph.

6. Keywords

Provide 5 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.

7. Subdivision of the article

For neatly structured paper, divide your article into clearly defined sections, subsections and sub-subsections numbered consecutively. Sections should, for example, be numbered 1,2,3, etc.; then subsections numbered 1.1, 1.2, 1.3, etc, and sub-subsections to be numbered 1.1.1, 1.1.2,1.1.3, etc. Note that the abstract is not included in section numbering.

8. References and Documentation

Author(s) should adhere strictly to Nigerian Association of Law Teachers Uniform Citation and Documentation Standards accessible at <u>www.naltng.org</u>.

- **9.** Names of authors cited in the footnotes should start with initials and end with the surname.
- **10.** Online sources should indicate the site and date of visit.
