GUIDELINES TO CONTRIBUTORS

- 1. Language:** The language of the manuscript must be English (British standards).
- 2. Originality:** Articles must be original and must not have been submitted for consideration and publication elsewhere.
- 3. Abstract:** Provide an abstract of not more than 200 words which briefly summarises the whole content and helps the reader quickly ascertain the purpose of the paper.
- 4. Keywords:** Provide 4 to 6 keywords which can be used for indexing purposes.
- 5. Title Page:** The title page should include: (i) The name(s) of the author(s), (ii) A concise and informative title, (iii) The affiliation(s) and address (es) of the author(s), (iv) The e-mail address, and telephone numbers of the corresponding author.
- 6. Length of paper:** The length of the paper should not exceed 8000 words or 20 pages. Articles should be typed in 1.5-line spacing (footnotes and references should appear in single line spacing) on one side of A4 paper only with wide margins.
- 7. Subdivision of the article:** Divide your article into clearly defined and numbered sections. Subsections should be numbered 1, 2. (then 1.1, 1.1.1, 1.1.2), 1.2, etc.). The abstract is not included in section numbering.
- 8. References:** Author(s) should adhere strictly to Nigerian Association of Law Teachers Uniform Citation and Documentation Standards accessible at www.naltng.org.
- 9.** The editors reserve the right to effect minor corrections in form and structure of papers submitted for publication
