The journal is designed for the publication of original articles, case reports, review articles, book reviews, historical/faith-based perspectives, editorials and letters to the editor in all aspects of medical, health, ethical and related research.

Article format

Manuscript must contain the following

headings – title; author(s) names; tagging; conflict(s) of interest; consent for publication; abstract; manuscript; references.

Title – must reflect the content of the article.

Author(s) names – Surname followed by initials of other names (e.g. Bala BST.); author(s) affiliation(s) and email address(es).

Tagging – specify in which of the following your article(s) falls into: original research article(s); review article(s); case report(s); Islamic perspective(s); book review(s); medical ethics; and history of medicine, health-related article(s).

Consent for publication – Authors are required to give IMJ consent for publication of the submitted paper, which must be done by filling in a consent for publication form containing: title of the publication; statement that the undersigned authors hereby transfer/assign or otherwise convey all copyright ownership of the manuscript to the IMJ; authors' names, signatures and dates; and the date of the submission. (Please note! If it's not possible to sign in to the word document, IMJ accepts submissions wherein only the author names and date are included.

Abstract – to have the following subheadings: introduction; methodology; results; and conclusion.

About the Journal

Keywords – not less than three and not more than five (i.e. between 3-5)

Manuscript (i.e. full length article) – to have the following subheadings: introduction; methodology; results (including tables and figures); discussion; and conclusion.

References – to be in citation-sequence style (i.e. Vancouver).

Acknowledgment - All persons who have made substantial contributions to the work reported in the manuscript, but who are not authors are credited here with the understanding that they have given the authors their written permission to be named. Non-inclusion of an Acknowledgment means that the authors have not received substantial contributions from non-authors and no author has been omitted.

Editorial process

Manuscripts are reviewed with the understanding that they represent original material, have never been published before, are not under consideration for publication elsewhere, and have been approved by all authors. Prior publication constitutes any form of publication other than an abstract and includes invited articles, proceedings, symposia, and book chapters. Authors must fully inform the Editor during the submission process if the submitted manuscript contains data and/or clinical observations that have been published or submitted for publication elsewhere, supply copies of such material, and explain the differences between the previous and submitted works. All accepted manuscripts become the property of Islamic Medical Association of Nigeria and may not be published elsewhere without written permission from Islamic Medical Association of Nigeria
